XIV. SALARY SCHEDULE AND OTHER PAY REGULATIONS

A. Salary

The salary schedules shall be in effect in accordance with the Appendices attached hereto. [Increase the base salary **1.25** % effective 8/1/2016 .5% effective 8/2014 and .5% effective 8/2015]

For the 2014-2015 school year teachers will move a full step but will receive 50% of the value of the step.

For the 2015-2016 school year teachers will resume with their regular step on the salary schedule at 100% of the value.

Non-salary schedule based compensation

In addition to the salary schedule based compensation above, each bargaining unit member who is not eligible to receive any vertical step increase in the $\frac{2014-2015}{2016-2016}$ and/or $\frac{2015-2016}{2016-2017}$ school years will receive a non-base building payment of .5% $\frac{1}{2016}$. The payment will be equally divided amongst each of the twenty-one (21) or twenty-six (26) pays in the school year.

XX. EFFECTS OF THE AGREEMENT

D. Duration

This Agreement shall be for a period of twenty-two and one-half (22-1/2) months with an effective date of July 1, 2014 and an expiration date of midnight, June 30, 2016.

This contract shall be extended for one (1) year and shall expire on midnight, June 30, 2017
