The current situation related to Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) is unprecedented. This is a fluid situation and there are far more questions than answers.

The CDC (Center for Disease Control) recommends the following best practices to minimize the spread of any of virus by following these steps:

- Wash your hands frequently.
- Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing. Cover with a tissue or by using your sleeve or elbow.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces including cell phones and other devices.
- Stay home when sick and don't return to school, socialize with friends or attend public events for at least 24 hours of being fever-free without the use of medication.
