

1. First Half Personal Property Tax Settlement

The first half personal property tax settlement was received on June 13, 2007. The total collection was \$27,084.72, less \$\$1,938.69 in deductions, which results in a net distribution of \$25,146.03.

2. Second Half Real Estate Tax Settlement

The second half real estate tax settlement was received on July 11, 2007. The total collection was \$3,236,719.46, less \$2,974,336.99 in deductions and advances, which results in a net distribution of \$262,382.47.
