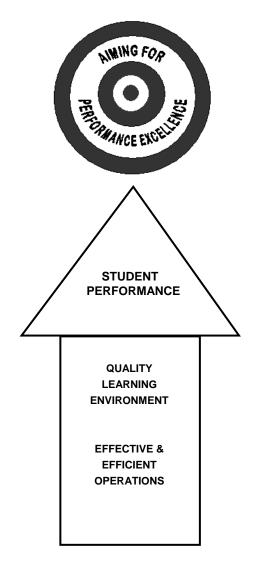

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR

WHEREAS, the Board of Education in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing July 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Ashtabula County, Ohio has certified its action thereon to this Board together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Board, and what part thereof is without, and what part within, the ten mill tax limitation;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, that the amount and rates, are as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said School District the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as per Schedule A attached hereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer of this Board be, and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the County Auditor of said County.

WHEREAS, the Buckeye Board of Education is desirous of participating in certain of the cooperative purchasing programs of the Ohio Schools Council, a council of governments organization under the law of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Buckeye Board of Education has reviewed the Agreement and Bylaws of the Ohio Schools Council and agrees to abide by them;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Buckeye Board of Education authorizes its Superintendent to initial the Agreement and Bylaws of the Ohio Schools Council and for its Treasurer to pay the annual fee.

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF AN EXISTING 1.9-MILL TAX LEVY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GENERAL PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2010, this Board adopted a resolution pursuant to Section 5705.03(B) of the Revised Code declaring it necessary to renew an existing 1.9-mill tax, having been for the purpose of "construction or acquisition of permanent improvements, including improvements of and repair to existing buildings; additions to or replacement of existing equipment, furniture or furnishings; and the acquisition of additional replacement motor vehicles", but determined by this Board pursuant to that resolution and Section 5705.21 of the Revised Code to be henceforth (upon renewal) for the purpose of "general permanent improvements", for five years, and requesting the Ashtabula County Auditor to certify the total current tax valuation of the School District and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by that 1.9-mill renewal levy; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2010, the Ashtabula County Auditor certified that the total tax valuation of the School District is \$269,295,680, and the dollar amount of revenue that would be produced by that 1.9-mill renewal levy would be \$459,705 ("+ P. Prop. Reimbursement \$152,494.81"), assuming the tax valuation remains constant throughout the life of the levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Buckeye Local School District, County of Ashtabula, State of Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1. This Board hereby finds, determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised by this Board within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax list and duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the School District, and that it is necessary to renew, for five years, an existing 1.9-mill ad valorem property tax outside of the ten-mill limitation, having been for the purpose of "construction or acquisition of permanent improvements, including improvements of and repair to existing buildings; additions to or replacement of existing equipment, furniture or furnishings; and the acquisition of additional replacement motor vehicles", but determined pursuant to a resolution adopted on June 30, 2010, and Section 5705.21 of the Revised Code, to be henceforth (upon renewal) for the purpose of "general permanent improvements".

Section 2. The question of the renewal of an existing 1.9-mill ad valorem property tax outside of the ten-mill limitation, for five years, for the purpose of general permanent improvements, beginning with the tax list and duplicate for the year 2011, the proceeds of which renewal levy first would be available to the School District in the calendar year 2012, shall be submitted under the provisions of Section 5705.21 of the Revised Code to the electors of the School District at an election to be held therein on November 2, 2010, as authorized by law. That election shall be held at the regular places of voting in the School District as established by the Ashtabula County Board of Elections, or otherwise, within the times provided by law and shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. The Treasurer of this Board be and is hereby authorized and directed to give or cause to be given notice of that election as provided by law.

Section 4. The Treasurer be and is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this resolution, the resolution referred to in the first preamble to this resolution and the related County Auditor's certificate, to the Ashtabula County Board of Elections before the close of business on August 4, 2010.

Section 5. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were held, in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its adoption.
