

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR RETAINING CERTAIN LEGAL SERVICES OF SCOTT, SCRIVEN & WAHOFF LLP IN CONNECTION WITH MATTERS RELATING TO SCHOOL LAW AND EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Buckeye Local School District Board of Education, ("Board") that:

Section 1. This Board approves the retention of the law firm of Scott, Scriven & Wahoff LLP (the "firm") for advice and assistance in matters relating to school law and employment relations as may be requested from time to time by the district superintendent, treasurer or board. Such services may include legal advice and representation in court or otherwise on such requested matters. The Board shall pay the firm reasonable fees for services rendered, plus out-of-pocket disbursements by the firm, such as large project copying costs, travel expenses, and long distance telephone charges.

Section 2. In rendering legal services, as an independent contractor and in an attorney-client relationship, the firm shall not exercise any administrative discretion on behalf of this Board in the formulation of public policy, the expenditure of public funds, or in the enforcement of any laws, rules, and regulations of the State, any county, cities, other political subdivisions, or of this Board, or the execution of public trusts.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
