

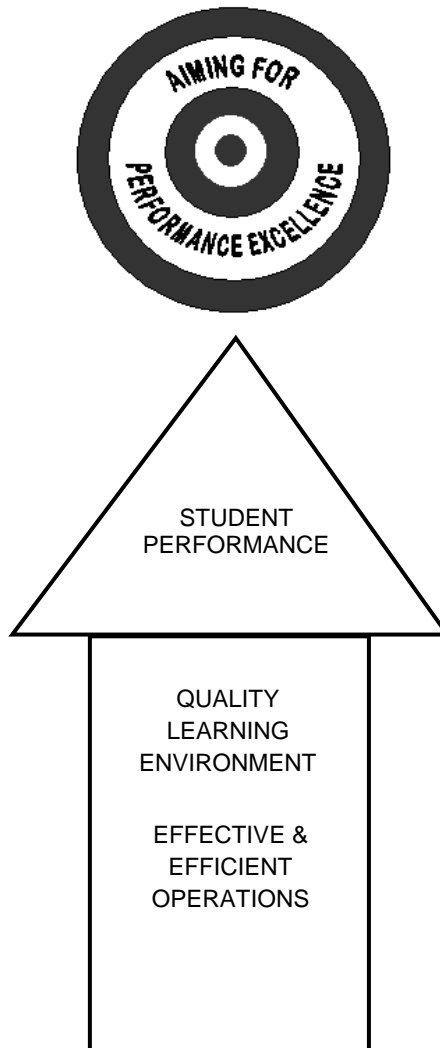

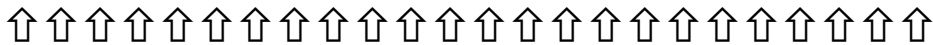

A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A RETAIL CUSTOMER SALES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND OHIO SCHOOLS COUNCIL (OSC), OHIO ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL BOARD OFFICIALS (OASBO), OHIO SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION (OSBA) AND BUCKEYE ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS (BASA) ENDORSED SUPPLIER, FIRSTENERGY SOLUTIONS CORP

WHEREAS, The Ohio Schools Council, the Ohio Schools Boards Association, the Ohio Association of Business Officials and the Buckeye Association of School Administrators established a program known as Power4Schools Electric Program to aggregate electricity purchasing for the benefit school districts; and

WHEREAS, participating public schools associated with the Power4Schools Program desire to purchase retail electric power services from the supplier of such services that has received the endorsement of OSC, OASBO, OSBA, and BASA, FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (the "Endorsed Supplier") for the Power4Schools Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education (the "Board") of this School District (the "District"), pursuant to this resolution desires to authorize the execution and delivery by the District of a retail customer sales agreement between the District and FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (the "Customer Sales Agreement"), pursuant to which the District, will purchase electricity generation at a discount for its school facilities; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Buckeye Local School District, County of Ashtabula, State of Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The Board authorizes and directs the Treasurer to execute and deliver, in the name of the District and on its behalf, the Customer Sales Agreement, substantially in the form now on file with this Board, with any changes that are not inconsistent with this resolution and that may be acceptable to the Treasurer whose acceptance shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution of such document by the Treasurer.

Section 2. Monies adequate to pay amounts due under the Customer Sales Agreement for the current fiscal year are hereby appropriated for that purpose.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
