RESOLUTION FOR NEW CONTINUING LEVY

District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, on the 7th day of November, the question of a new levy of 1.5 mills per year for a continuing period of time, for each dollar of the taxable property within Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, for the purpose of paying the current operating expenses of the Kingsville Public Library, Ashtabula County, Ohio, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 3375.17, 5705.03 and 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code. Said levy to appear upon the tax duplicate of said Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation will be insufficient to pay the current expenses of said Kingsville Public Library in **Buckeye Local**School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to levy taxes in excess of said limitation for the purpose of paying the current expenses of said Kingsville Public Library of Ashtabula County, Ohio,;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Buckeye Local School District,

Ashtabula County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That in accordance with Sections 3375.17, 5705.03 and 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code, there shall be submitted to the electors of Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, the question of a new levy of 1.5 mills per years for a continuing period of time for each dollar of the taxable property within said Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, which proposed renewal rate of taxation, expressed in dollars and cents, for each \$100.00 valuation, will amount to \$0.15, for the current operating expenses of Kingsville Public Library in said Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, and that the ballot submitted to the electors shall set forth said levy is a levy of 1.5 mills for the benefit

of Kingsville Public Library, for the purpose aforesaid, and shall be levied in said **Buckeye Local**School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, for a continuing period of time.

SECTION 2. That the said question is to be submitted to the electors of **Buckeye Local** School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, on November 7, 2017; that said election shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in like manner as regular elections in **Buckeye Local School** District, for the election of officials thereof, and shall be submitted in the manner and form provided by Section 5705.23 of the Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That the Treasurer of Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Ashtabula County, Ohio, which shall give thirty (30) days' notice of said election in one or more newspapers printed and of general circulation within Buckeye Local School District, Ashtabula County, Ohio, once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks, on the same day of the week, prior to the election, specifying in said notice the proposed rate to be levied, the purpose for which it is to be levied, and the numbers of years during which said levy is to be in effect, and the time and place of holding the election.

SECTION 4. As provided in Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Resolution shall go into immediate effect, and no publication as same shall be necessary other than that provided for in the notice of election.

"Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of personal and public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
- 2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf.
- 3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
