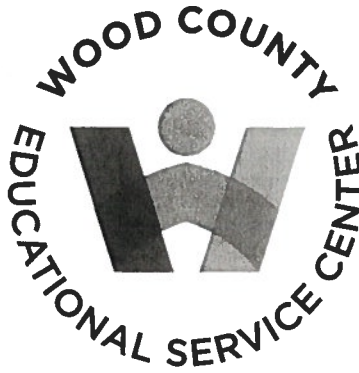
The education program will continue to utilize the direct billing method that has been employed for the previous years.

State testing documents should be scheduled in advance of the planned date of administration please.
