Recommendations for Adult Breakfast Price Increase and Adult Meals

Regulations at 7CFR 210.14(e) require school food authorities (SFAs) participating in the National School Lunch Program to ensure sufficient funds are provided to the nonprofit school food service account for meals served to students not eligible for free or reduced price meals. There are two ways to meet this requirement: either through the prices charged for “paid” meals or through other non-Federal sources provided to the nonprofit school food service account.

I am recommending an increase in the Adult price of school breakfast so that the program is in compliance with National School Lunch Program regulations.

Current Breakfast Price	\$2.00
Recommended increase to	\$2.50

I am also recommending an increase in the Adult meal prices for the District. USDA requires that “All adult meal prices should be, at a minimum, the current Federal free lunch reimbursement rate + meal value of USDA foods + taxes if applicable =

$$\$4.32 + 0.3975 = \$4.7150$$

Current adult price \$3.75

Recommended increase of adult meals to \$4.75. Milk is separate at \$.50.
