

Important Information Regarding Meal Payment Status for the 2022-23 School Year

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Caregivers:

Please be aware that the federal program that allowed us to provide all students with free breakfast and lunch last school year will no longer be in place for the 2022-2023 school year. We will be reverting to the free or reduced meal applications used prior to the pandemic.

We will utilize the information you submitted for the 2021-22 school year to determine your meal payment status for the first 30 days. The 30 day carryover period will end on September 30, 2022.

If you did not complete a free/reduced meal application for the 2021-22 school year, your student/students will be at full price at the start of school 2022-23.
